

Abstract *Staphylococcus aureus* is a major cause of nosocomial infections. The aim of this study was to determine the prevalence of *S. aureus* in the intensive care unit (ICU) of a tertiary care hospital in the city of Bogotá, Colombia. A total of 100 patients were enrolled in the study. The prevalence of *S. aureus* was 100% in the ICU. The most common source of infection was the respiratory tract (100%). The most common risk factor for infection was the use of mechanical ventilation (100%). The most common antibiotic used was vancomycin (100%). The most common resistance pattern was resistance to methicillin (100%).

These data suggest, however, that patients with a more severe form of the disorder, such as those with a history of hospitalization, may benefit more from treatment with aripiprazole than from treatment with placebo.
